NEEDS Analysis & Specific Objectives

Raising the capacity of NGOs working with youth with metrics:

- 2 living **labs** in 2 MENA countries (min 40 young people to participate)
- 2 non-formal **trainings** in MENA countries (min 25 young people to participate in each one)
- 1 **summer** school for **trainers** (min 10 people participation)



NEEDS Analysis & Specific Objectives

- Closing **conference** with 100 participants
- 80 percent **females** engaged in the process
- 1 **website** to track SEEDS Evolution (e-learning platform: 5 modules (4 technical, 1 entrepreneurial))
- 1 Agriculture **course** 4.0 (enhancing entrepreneurial skills & Fair Trade Principles)



NEEDS Analysis & Specific Objectives

- 1 strategy regarding follow-up of SEEDS for the future RE-KOLTA and RESEED, concepts that will follow a stronger built **network** in MENA countries.
- min. 50% of the **training** will be involved in the Living Labs activities.
- 1 formal education **stakeholder** per MENA country will be contacted and attracted in the SEEDS activities.
- 1 formal education **stakeholder** from Europe will be attracted and involved in MENA activities

 - **digital** dimension, by introducing through **non-formal learning**, the new advances of IoT and **digital** in agriculture, paving the way to **Agriculture 4.0**;
 - **common values, civic engagement** and **participation**, by sharing, consulting and involving communities, local and national, in the SEEDS activities



Impacts for participating organizations:

- increased knowhow about **regenerative agriculture** and health farms and smart farming;
- exchanged **knowhow** in **agriculture** close to **desert** area;
- increased capacity to **develop curricula** and teaching/learning materials as well as **training** people;
- improved understanding of **approaching** target groups – youth with **lower opportunities** due to social exclusion;
- improved skills to define **tailor-made solutions** for target groups;
- increased capacity to develop and implement Erasmus+ projects;
- improved **collaboration** and **networking** on European level and across MENA countries;
- better **anchorage** in their host regions
